The Governor's Office of Homeland Security is offering a statewide virtual summit on Human Trafficking for law enforcement, investigators and prosecutors. Pending approval, continuing education (CLEE) credits will be available for law enforcement through the Municipal Police Officers' Education & Training Commission.

The presentations will identify how law enforcement can proactively locate victims of human trafficking, obtain probable cause in labor trafficking cases, and collect evidence in these unique cases that will lead to successful prosecutions at the Commonwealth level. Case studies will be provided to demonstrate how these investigations are constructed and challenges that can be mitigated.

Techniques and insight will be provided on how to establish proactive task forces directed to counter labor trafficking in Pennsylvania, with attention given to law enforcement investigation strategies, victim interaction and evidence collection.
