After downloading the form to your computer from the webpage. Close out of your web browser. Open the form on your computer, **do not open it in your web browser**, then fill in the data fields. When you get to the bottom of the last page, and are ready to sign the form, click on the **Signature** field.

Configure a Digital ID for signing

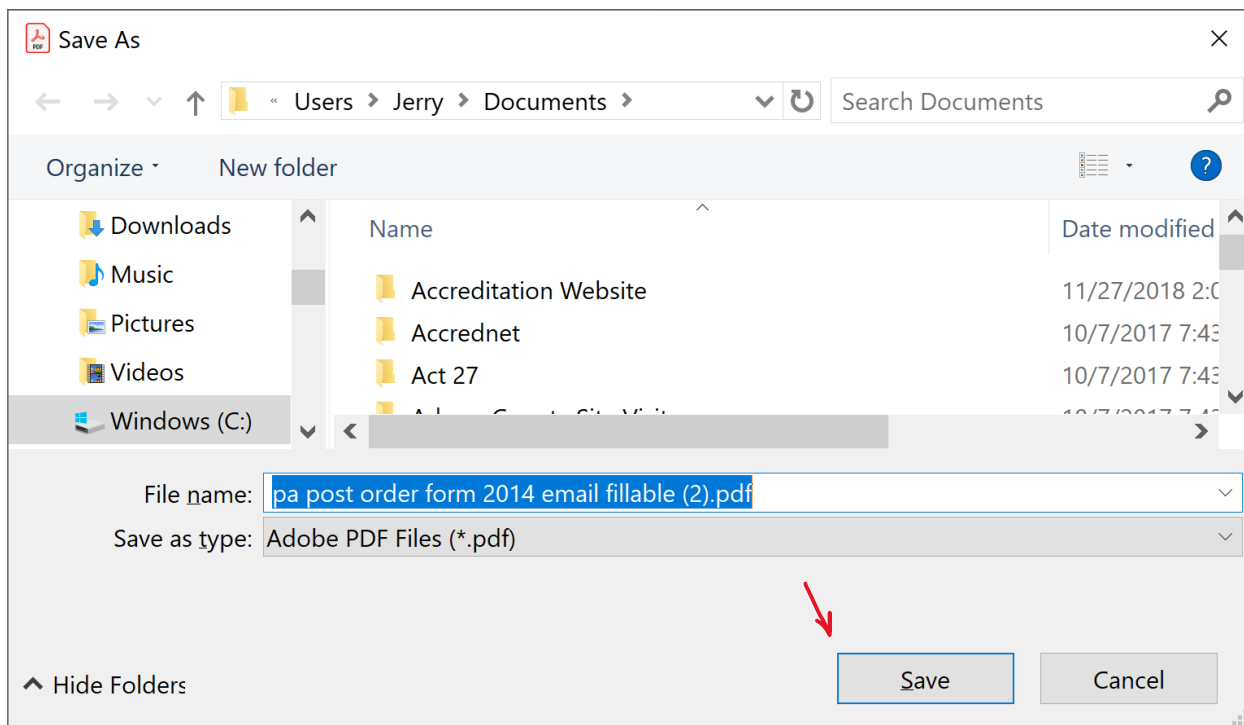
